The lower level houses two additional bedrooms, two bathrooms, a separate kitchen, a bonus room, and a laundry space. Gorgeous wrap-around, covered decks on both levels provide the perfect spot to enjoy your preferred beverage while overlooking the enchanting grounds that include hiking trails, mesmerizing water features, outdoor showers, and magnificent Japanese gardens, all with a stunning backdrop of luxuriant mountain views. The primary lot is 6.37 acres; the secondary lot is 11.47 acres and encompasses a nearly-level mountaintop knoll, perfect for a second dwelling. Well-loved and

maintained, Hinoki House is a true treasure nestled in the ideal setting.
